Gabrielle's workshop features a spiritually oriented, attachment based approach to helping couples and others understand and improve their relationships, at home and at work, through The Art of Intentional Loving.

This 7-week workshop will provide both a psycho-educational and hands-on experiential approach to learning new skills and new ways of thinking about how to relate. A Message from the director:

On October 27, 1986, Pope John Paul II invited the leaders of all the Christian denominations and well as the leaders of all the world religions to come to Assisi to pray for peace. This year marks the 25th anniversary of this momentous occasion. However we will not commemorate with a single event. Instead we have decided to celebrate the work for and achievement of peace for the entire month of October. We are asking for help from the OLA community and those who hold the Franciscan Renewal Center close to their heart.

1. We are soliciting Peace Stories. Please share, in writing, a story of working for peace in a situation of conflict or a story of reconciliation achieved. These actions could have taken place in your family, in your local community or on a larger level. Please keep your story to 350 words and send to me at the email address below. We need them by mid-September. Below is an example of a Peace story from a Casa Community member.

Since 2005, I have been an active member of Pax Christi-Phoenix. On April 18, 2007, several of us took the Vow of Nonviolence. **One precept is to persevere in nonviolence of tongue and heart.**

Over the Martin Luther King Holiday weekend in January 2008, I went backpacking with three friends in the Superstition Wilderness east of Phoenix. Twice I lashed out about one of our elected officials, attempting to defame and assassinate that official's character. I realized while this was happening how much I wanted to attack and hurt this person's reputation and stature in the eyes of two ardent supporters. I was using my self-righteous anger to "arm my heart," and not disarm it in partnership with the nonviolent Christ. I was closing off my heart to ever including this person in the Beloved Community, in God's reign of peace and justice and poisoning the discussion with my friends, making meaningful dialogue more difficult.

Taking the vow of nonviolence is easy. Living it is a constant challenge. I pray that the image of disarmament and Jesus' admonition to "Put down the sword" of my heart, mind, and lips will help make room in me for nonviolent language and dialogue without venom or rancor. Paz y Bien.

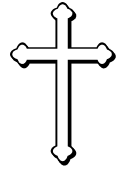

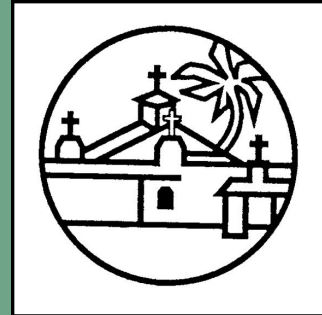
