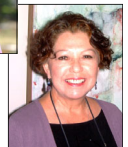

Spirit of Assisi Renewed

You may have noticed the new rainbow colored PEACE flags hanging at the entrance to the FRC. These flags, that say PEACE in Italian, come from Assisi. Hopefully you also noticed the prayer flags hanging in the Hospitality area and added one of your own. Together, these are visible reminders that we need to continually pray and work for Peace. Peace comes about intentionally. It is not the absence of violence rather it is the work of reconciliation, healing, and justice. We are encouraged to be mindful of situations that need actions for Peace and then have the courage to act.

Last week in the bulletin we handed out Peace Cards with Peace stories. There are around 35 different stories of peace on those cards. Each one tells of an action taken to bring Peace to an individual, a group of people, or to a region of the world. These cards also have nine different actions one can take to create peace in our own community. 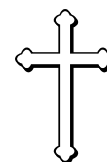

Not because the Casa needs it, but because you need it. God is trying to give you an amazing gift. Don't deny Him or yourself this experience. It is easy. This year the Family Catechesis and Sacrament Preparation programs have almost doubled! Welcome to all our new families and friends! We have 122 students registered in our family catechesis process, plus another 12 children in the RCIA process, plus another 55 for First Reconciliation and 38 for confirmation/Eucharist. Many thanks to you as Casa community for being a shining example of God's love and welcome, drawing these families into our midst. This catechetical process is not a program outside of "church" but an integral part of our community. It is a faith journey that we share together as we grow in relationship to Christ and to one another. With these numbers also comes more responsibilities. We are still looking for breakout aides for grades 2 and 3. Each class needs an extra pair of hands to help facilitate the session. You are not required to teach (unless you want to), but you are required to complete the diocesan Call to Protect training. That class will be offered here on **Wednesday, Nov. 16th.**

The time requirement: about an hour and a half on the Third Sunday of each month.

The heart requirement: To show God's love to these children and families by example.

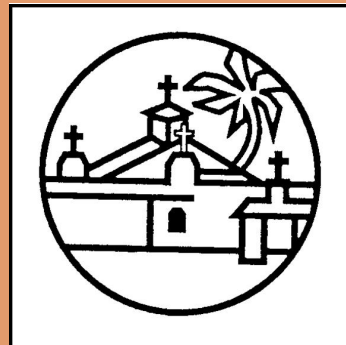
