We value the coincidence of opposites as such a major component of our Franciscan charism. You know Francis loved mountains. He loved the effort involved with the climb as well as the reward, which was solitude and the view. It was in this paradox that the work of sweat and hiking, which is, in a sense, some suffering, results in beauty and joy after the conquest.

Francis conceives the Canticle of the Creatures and speaks with delight even in the suffering his body and eyes are enduring. Francis lives a life that says only a fool refuses to forgive. Francis never sought to seek revenge. That is hard to do and feels the opposite of what justice calls us to do. Yet, in Francis, we learn that the journey has struggle and fear. The mountain is difficult to climb.

That the inner cave is where we deal with the internal debates our minds have, that in the solitude is sometimes the clamor. That in the poor and suffering of our world are the evangelists calling us to reform and renew. That the comfortable are made uncomfortable, and the uncomfortable are comforted.

We bring forth the God within and in each other; that is incarnational living that demonstrates this coincidence of opposites.

The AMS provides pastoral ministries to those serving in the U.S Armed Services, enrolled in U.S. Military Academies, undergoing treatment at any of the 153 Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, working in civilian jobs for the federal government beyond U.S. borders, and for the families of these populations.

### Reflecting on the Word as a Family - Luke 20: 27, 34-38

In this Sunday's gospel, the Sadducees were questioning Jesus because what Jesus taught about the resurrection and life after death was not what they believed. So, what was Jesus teaching about life after death? When Jesus died and then rose from the dead he did not just come back to life, he was transformed! His own friends did not recognize him at first. 


