- ~ All are welcome here. Remember that the way we welcome children in the church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.

The Feast of Our Lady of the Angels

**Tuesday, August 2
A Festive Liturgy at 5 pm**

Come celebrate our community feast day!
Understand more of our Franciscan heritage
as we commemorate our namesake ...
“the Portiuncula” in Assisi
(The Chapel of Our Lady of the Angels.)

Francis came to a place called the Portiuncula (which means “the little portion”) where there was an old church dedicated to the Mother of God, which had been abandoned with no one to look after it. This was a tiny chapel, hidden away in the woods and marshes near Assisi. Francis had great devotion to Mary, and when he saw that the church was deserted, he began to live there constantly in order to repair it. He heard that the angels often visited it, so that it used to be called Saint Mary of the Angels, and he decided to stay there permanently out of reverence for the angels and love for the Mother of Christ. He loved this spot more than any other in the world. It was here that he began his religious life in a very small way; it was here that he made such extraordinary progress, and it was here that he came to a happy end. This was the place where St. Francis founded the Order of Friars Minor. He often said to the friars, “My sons, see that you never abandon this place! If you are driven out of one door, re-enter by another, for this place is holy indeed; it is the dwelling place of Christ and His Mother.” The Basilica which now covers the little chapel was begun in 1569. It was meant to accommodate the huge crowds of pilgrims. As we honor Our Lady of the Angels, may we find inspiration for our own growth and development in the gospel way of life that Francis embraced and lived so completely.

Gospel Reflection for Parents

When someone in our family is going through a hard time, we can't just sit by and watch. We try to do everything we can to let him or her know that he or she is not alone. Sometimes we even try to find a special gift for him or her—something that will help that person to understand how important he or she is to us. Talk about times in your family when this has happened.

In our Gospel for today, like a good father, God saw that his children needed help. He decided to offer his beloved children a special gift to reveal his love. What did God give us? Not a thing, but a person—the Father's beloved Son, Jesus. Jesus, in turn, taught us to approach God as we would approach a loving father. He gave us the words of a prayer that we call the Our Father, or the Lord's Prayer.

As you gather to talk to your children about today's Gospel, begin by reading aloud Luke 11:1-13. Talk about how Jesus teaches us to be persistent in prayer. Think of times when family members were persistent about something until they were able to achieve a goal or receive what they sought. Talk about what it means to be persistent in prayer. Help your children understand that prayer is not like sitting on Santa Claus's lap, asking for what we want until we get it. Emphasize that prayer is a way of striving to recognize how God is reaching out to us in love and responding by presenting him with our needs. Conclude this time together by joining hands and praying the Lord's Prayer. (Sunday Connection, Loyola Press)



COMMUNITY CONNECTION



Like many, I felt isolated and overwhelmed during the pandemic. The world was spinning out of control, and all I could do was eat, drink, and pray. I needed a focus beyond my own isolation, so I turned to the FRC in search of a mission. As a former volunteer manager, I knew I'd find purpose in the service of others. I chose to get involved with Casa Habitat for Humanity and Valley Interfaith Project Faith In Action ministries.

Of course the world was locked down, so my first interaction was a Zoom meeting where I met the VIP core team. I felt an instant bond with this group. We talked about the issues important to us such as housing, education, water, Covid, and the social, racial, and political divisions in our community. They shared the same sense of urgency I had to get involved and be agents for change — and not one of them was under the age of 60!

I believe VIP is immensely important because the issues at the heart of this ministry affect us all. As Catholics we are called to serve the common good and the most vulnerable in our community. VIP is not about politics or party affiliation. It is about justice and human dignity. It has helped me understand the importance of measuring our laws and policies against Catholic social teaching and holding our elected officials accountable. The impact of this ministry has the power to affect future generations, so it is critically important for our young people to get involved.

I'm grateful to be a part of both Habitat and VIP. I've found new friendships, become more civically engaged, and my commitment to my faith has deepened — exactly the spiritual renewal I needed.
