In the Season of Lent, it is customary to pray the Stations of the Cross, a beautiful devotional practice that reminds us that we are to take up the cross with Jesus, who teaches us and accompanies us through the challenges of daily life. The Stations of the Resurrection — or the “Way of Light” — highlights the continuing presence of the Risen Lord as we recognize His guidance and leadership through the events of our daily living.

Both of these devotional itineraries echo the paschal mystery of the death *and* resurrection of Jesus. Walking both the Way of the Cross and the Way of Light helps us identify with the Lord, who always walks ahead, behind, and all around us.

In our midst this Easter season is not only the cross but also the Easter candle reminding each one of us of our essential identity and our mission: to bear the cross and carry the light, both of which were entrusted to us at our baptism.

At “The Stations of the Resurrection,” we will meditate upon Jesus’ rising from the dead and discover the pathway of light that He blazes through our lives. We pray for help to walk this pilgrimage of faith — this Way of Light — as daughters and sons of the Light, witnesses of His Resurrection and continued presence. May we recognize His dying and rising in our own life experiences and in our midst. May walking this Way of Light make us more confident “light-bearers” in our beautiful but fragile world.

The Casa community is invited to stand together in solidarity with our Jewish sisters and brothers and all who perished during the Holocaust. Yellow Candles will be distributed after all the Masses on April 23 and 24, to be lit in your homes on Wednesday night, April 27, 2022. The Yellow Candle Project was created in 1981 to keep alive the memory of the six million Jews who perished in the Holocaust. (The candle’s yellow wax serves to remind us of the yellow star badges which Jews were forced to wear during the Nazi regime, intended to humiliate and mark them out for segregation and discrimination.)
