#### PASTORAL REFLECTION

#### The Centenary of Centenaries

You might have heard us mention that this year we'll be celebrating the 800th Anniversary of the Christmas experience of St. Francis of Assisi in the little Italian village of Greccio. This started the tradition of setting up nativity scenes in our churches, towns, and homes. But that's not the only 800th Anniversary coming up!

Over the next four years, we will have the opportunity to reflect and contemplate:

- the Rule of the Order of Franciscans (1223-2023)
- Christmas in Greccio (1223-2023)
- the Stigmata of St. Francis (1224-2024)
- the composition of the poem "Canticle of the Creatures" (1225- 2025)
- the death of St. Francis of Assisi (1226-2026)

Worldwide, the celebration of the Centennials has the purpose of directing our gaze toward the future and strengthening our Franciscan identity. These events to be commemorated over the next four years are a singularly unique Franciscan moment — a chance for anyone who is inspired by the life and work of St. Francis of Assisi to deepen that understanding and embrace more fully this beautiful spirituality. This also becomes an occasion to support the reform that Pope Francis is carrying out in his pontificate.

The five Centenaries are part of a single thematic project, which will develop gradually and harmoniously according to the chronology of the events celebrated. This has all been conceived and developed by brothers and sisters from all continents. Without a doubt, this will be a good opportunity to give visibility to the Franciscan Family as a whole. ## Mass with the Anointing of the Sick Sat., Feb. 11 at 10:30 am

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray. Is anyone in good spirits? He should sing praise. Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. (Ja 5:13-20)

#### Reflecting on the Word as a Family - Matthew 5:13-16

Being a Christian is not passive. We cannot sit and watch the world and not be a part of it. As Christians we are called to be the "salt of the earch" and the "light of the world." Salt is not made to sit in a bowl and never be used. Its purpose is to be added to food for flavor. In Jesus' time it was also used often as a preservative. Light also is meant to push away the darkness. Jesus calls us to take the light that we have received from his love and let it touch every part of our life and the lives of those around us. We are called to bring flavor, preservation, and transformation in our lives!

#### Discussing the Word as a Family

*On the way to Mass*: What does salt do to food? What could Jesus be asking of us when he calls us to be the salt of the earth?

On the way home from Mass: What happens to a light that is placed under a basket? What if light is placed on a lampstand? If our light is the love of Jesus that he has given us, what might he want us to do with it?

#### Living the Word as a Family

Reread today's Gospel together with this visual: light a candle and place it under a basket (you could use an electic candle if you have little ones.) With the lights in the room off, ask your family to share what they observe about the light. Then remove the candle from under the basket and place it on a counter or coffee table and share your observations again. What new insights does anyone have about the Gospel when they see what happens to the lit candle? (Adapted from *Celebrating Sunday for Catholic Families*)


