Today's Gospel reminds us of how difficult following Christ can be. Jesus lays out the reality that not everyone will make it to the Kingdom of Heaven. He notes that people from the east to west, north to south, who put into practice the Gospel way of life, will join him at the table in heaven. This is about desire and action, no matter who the person is.

Who are these people from all over that will be at His table? You actually may know some of them. Do you have a friend, family member, or co-worker who longs to sit at this table? Someone who is questioning where God is leading them? Or perhaps who is looking for a place of belonging and purpose?

Maybe inviting them to check out the Christian Initiation process (RCIA) is an action you can take to help a seeker take their first steps toward the Kingdom of Heaven. This process is for those who are not baptized, baptized in another faith, or Catholic but not catechized. RCIA is not only the journey to full initiation in the Catholic church but to the discipleship of action that we are all called to.

We have the choice within our own hearts, exemplified by our actions, to love others as Christ loves us. What better way to share this than by inviting a seeker to "Come and see." Contact Patty Tafolla at dcm@thecasa.org or talk to an RCIA team member after mass these next two weeks.

Mass with the Anointing of the Sick This Saturday, Aug. 27 at 10:30 am

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray.

Is anyone in good spirits? He should sing praise.

Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up.

(Ja 5:13-20)




Gospel Reflection for Parents

Sometimes the Gospel readings can be very difficult to relate to our lives. Even though the words were for a specific audience at the time, Jesus' message to us is timeless and sometimes we must dig a little deeper to discover why this really matters. Today's Gospel is a good example. What Jesus is saying seems completely counterintuitive to the merciful message of the parable

of the forgiving father or the loving shepherd that goes out looking for the lost sheep. The master has locked some of these people out! Some people have taken it for granted that they can get in any time they wish. If Christ's message is always about loving God and loving others, why then this message of trying to get through the "narrow gate?" I suppose it comes down to our free will to choose. Do we make the conscious choice in our own heart and our actions to love others as Christ loves us? Or do we choose not to? Do we take each other for granted or show our family, friends, and those we go to school or work with? Or do we show them that we appreciate them? It comes down to our choices. It is easy to want to do good. It is far more challenging to put it into practice daily.


