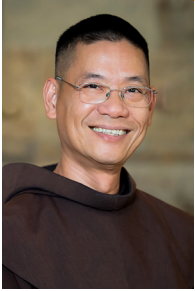

PASTORAL REFLECTION



Dear Holy People of God,
In a world where peace is often equated with power, and security with walls and weapons, the second reading this Sunday gives us a startling reversal. Here, at the very center of heaven's throne, is not a lion, not a conqueror in armor, but a Lamb. And not just any lamb—but one who was slain. This Lamb, marked by sacrifice, is also the Shepherd.

“The Lamb who is in the center of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to springs of life-giving water.”

This is a logic that baffles the world. The one who leads us to true peace is not the strongest by worldly standards, but the one who gave everything out of love. Security is not found in control, but in surrender to the Shepherd who knows our wounds, because He bears them Himself. Security and peace are not the absence of pain and war, but the presence of God.

This is the peace we long for. Not a fragile calm built on fear or force, but the unshakeable peace that comes from being known and loved by the One who leads us to living waters. And in the end, the tenderest image: God will wipe away every tear. God wipes away our tears—one by one—as only a loving Father can.

This is the upside-down glory of heaven. This is the hope that anchors us now. Let us follow the Lamb, even through the roughest valley, trusting He will lead us to life.
