PASTORAL REFLECTION



I have a friend who is an extraordinary human being and has impacted the lives of many through her 30-plus years of teaching.

Early on in our friendship, I didn't have an appreciation for the contributions she made to

the community through her tireless devotion to educating our youngest citizens. This would change over time, of course, as we were frequently approached by adults we'd see out and about, and these former students would approach her and tell her how much they loved being in her class as children. Some of them even had their children in her class years later. It was a time for me to see how much more she was to the world and not just my friend I knew from church choir.

Each of us goes through our day-to-day lives, and we often never realize who we encounter. We see a kind face, say hello, and go on about our business. How many truly amazing people do we see and never know the gift that they are?

Peter, James, and John walked with Jesus every day and thought they knew him. Then they were shown in a most profound way that he was so much more than they could have imagined. What must that walk back down the mountain have been like?

We have Jesus in our lives — in the Living Word, in the Eucharist, and in the people gathered in his name. Can we truly see the gift he is in our lives?



COMMUNITY CONNECTION



My name is Rick Sain. My history with the Casa began in 1993 – 1997 when I worked as a cook in the kitchen under Chef Kathy Fitzgerald. I already knew Father Alonso and met all of the Casa employees. My wife and I attended Masses at the Casa and later we became full members of the Franciscan Renewal Center. Pre-Covid, we usually attended the 7:30 am Mass on Sundays.

I started volunteering with the Casa Habitat Ministry in 2019 after I heard an announcement at Mass that the signup tables were outside. In five years, since 2019, I have helped to complete seven homes. On my second build, I helped to build a house from the beginning at the wall signing to the day of the dedication when the homeowner, the family, gets the keys to their house. I was hooked, it was like a "sugar rush," and I could not get enough of it and could not wait until the next build.

In February 2024, I will be starting my eighth house. It's fun to volunteer and help a family get a home. I'm now on the Casa Habitat Core/Leadership Team. For some builds, I agree to bring my grill and enjoy cooking hamburgers and hot dogs to feed all the habitat builders at our site. I invite you to keep an open mind, come and sign up, and go to the build and see if you get as hooked as I did. You will meet your fellow Casa Habitat crew and learn some new skills.
