The season of Lent has arrived. During my early twenties, as a new Catholic, I quickly realized that there are many diverse ways Catholics observe Lent. These practices stem from culture, tradition, family dynamics, and personal faith decisions. On this

first Sunday of Lent, it's noteworthy that we are presented with the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert by the devil.

This year, we hear Luke's account, which varies slightly from Matthew's and is certainly more detailed than Mark's brief reference. One thing is clear: the devil deliberately chose a moment when Jesus was particularly vulnerable. After fasting for 40 days, Jesus was not only hungry but likely exhausted, making it the perfect opportunity for the devil to strike. He targeted Jesus' identity, emphasizing what St. Luke deeply highlights throughout his Gospel. In a similar vein, our Lenten journey focuses on identity, and the devil aimed to weaponize that very identity against Jesus. Twice he challenges, "If you are the Son of God..." and even cites Scripture (Psalm 91) to lure Jesus into the game he wishes to play.

How often does our faith encounter challenges related to our identities? When are we most susceptible to such challenges? What situations does the devil exploit in each of us to attack our identity as God's children? And how does this influence our celebration of Lent this year?

This humble walking prayer follows Jesus' path to Calvary, inviting us into contemplation of His Passion. We begin near the Meditation Chapel.

6–7 pm: Simple Soup Supper (location varies)
Our Casa kitchen prepares a healthy and simple meal of soup and bread. The community shares it together, and donations are collected and given to the poor.

7 pm: Taizé Prayer Around the Cross (in the church)
This prayer blends meditative singing and periods of silence. Contemplative short chants, repeated over and over, express a basic reality of faith, quickly grasped by the mind. This beautifully peaceful service lasts about 40 minutes.
