In today's Responsorial Psalm, we pray that God will heal the broken hearted, which is a human condition that most of us have surely experienced for time to time. Broken heartedness is certainly a difficult part of life as we know it, and it comes about from a litany of causes, all of which stem from our relationships with others. The question is, how do we deal with a broken heart?

Some say take a couple of aspirins and get some sleep. James Taylor in his song "Handy Man" says in the lyrics: "Here is the main thing that I want to say, I'm busy 24 hours a day, I fix broken hearts..." The real and true healing answer comes from a phrase that many of us learned way back when...

"Let Go and Let God."

The more independent we choose to be, the more difficult it is for us to let go and trust God. We say we want to be "self-reliant" and work things out on our own. The fact is that we can do nothing without God's help, and He alone is the healer of broken hearts.

Today's Responsorial Psalm is well worth reading and praying over again and again.

Mass with the Anointing of the Sick Saturday, February 10 at 10:30 am

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

*Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray.
Is anyone in good spirits? He should sing praise.
Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. (Ja 5:13-20)*

COMMUNITY CONNECTION



For decades, the Franciscan Renewal Center has worked to reduce our carbon footprint around campus. Efforts to harness renewable energy began with solar arrays installed (30) on the Friary (2010); (92) on the Assisi lodging building (2015); and (140) on the Community Life Center (2019). Our commitment to answering the call of Pope Francis' encyclical "*Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home*" continues as we find new opportunities to expand renewable energy usage.

In mid-December, we began installing 371 additional solar panels on five roofs, including the Dining Room, Capistrano, St. Agnes/St. Barbara/Apartments, Sr. Luca, and an expansion on the Friary. The work is expected to be completed by mid-February, followed by an APS inspection for activation.

- The existing three solar arrays on the Friary, Assisi, and Community Life Center produce approximately 100,000kW, 14% of our electricity needs.
- The 371 new panels will produce an additional 250,000Kwh, bringing total electricity generation to about 50% of the Casa's needs.

Thanks to a generous donor and a possible tax credit (up to 30%) from the Inflation Reduction Act, this project will provide great ecological and financial benefits to the Franciscan Renewal Center.

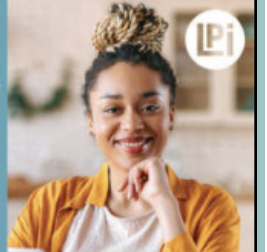

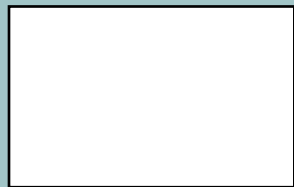

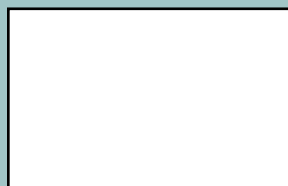
