Today, we remember the Lord's Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Starting today and all throughout Holy Week, we will reflect on Christ's woundedness.

Ultimately, this Friday, we will gather in prayer to remember our Lord's Passion on the Cross. The word vulnerable comes from the Latin verb vulnerare which means "to wound." Jesus must have felt hurt learning that his betrayal prophecy came true after Judas Iscariot turned him over to the Roman authorities. We learn that on Good Friday he becomes physically, mentally, and emotionally wounded.

This week, we will learn how Jesus' own woundedness on the Cross allows God's love to flow through us. You might have heard the old saying that "hurt people hurt people, loved people love people," Holy Week challenges us by turning that phrase on its head. Woundedness makes us human after all.

How can you transform your own woundedness into a love that is wholehearted and expressive of God's love?

Holy Week and The Easter Triduum

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the **Easter Triduum** — from the evening of Holy Thursday (*the Mass of the Lord's Supper*) to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum has an honored place at the heart of the liturgical year, and marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads us to the Season of Easter! These liturgies are at the center of our Christian identity. Join together as we remember ... and celebrate our faith.

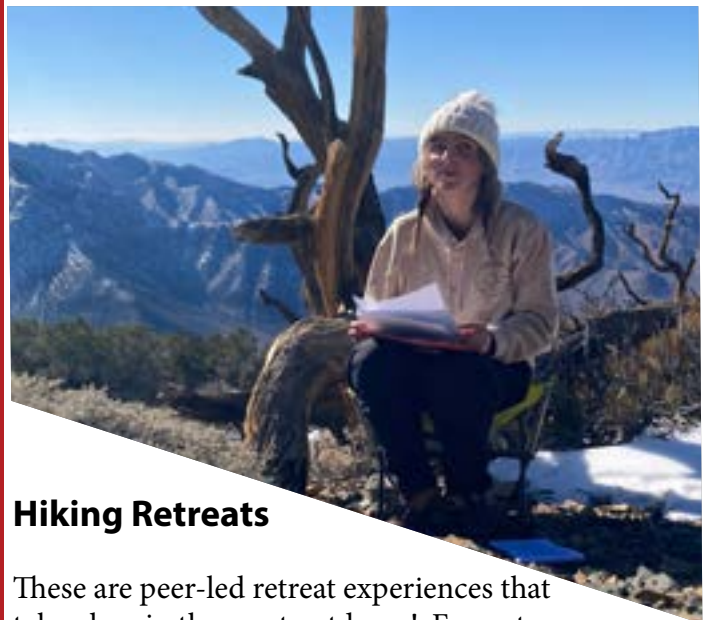

COMMUNITY CONNECTION



In 2004 I served in Iraq as an army combat medic, where I sustained physical, mental, emotional & spiritual injuries. In 2015 I learned of moral injury/conflict and in 2017 I was able to attend a Healing of Memories (HOM) workshop for veterans, offered by the Casa Veterans Ministry (CVM). I had done my mind and body work and found through HOM that I was able to address the moral injuries that incurred in war, which was the final piece to make my soul whole and complete.

I serve as an HOM lead facilitator for veterans, first responders, and police, and as the program coordinator for healthcare workers. Additionally, I am a group facilitator at the CVM for the 8 week – Building Spiritual Strength program for veterans and VA healthcare workers, which addresses the moral injuries/conflict to include the St. Francis Beyond the Wounded Warrior Resiliency Retreat.

The Army motto of never leaving a soldier behind is what motivates and drives me to support and assist those to help themselves on their journey. And through my personal lived-experiences and suffering, I have found that there is an abundance of love and life after trauma, which inspires my personal healing work so that in the end, I will be able to serve the Divine's entire human family.

I am very thankful and grateful to be a part of the CVM team and to be one of the lead facilitators for our upcoming women veteran's Healing of Memories on April 12–14, at the Franciscan Renewal Center.

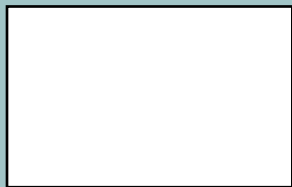
