PASTORAL REFLECTION



I was not raised Catholic and entered full communion with the Church in 2006. Over the years, as I learned more about the faith, I realized the importance of the communal aspects of being a Catholic. Our faith is not about me and God. It's about us and God. As we live out our faith, we are important to each other.

In today's Gospel, it seems that John left out some important information. It jumps from one scene to the next. This seems a bit frustrating not knowing all the details of what is happening. Yet, to get a better picture of these experiences with Jesus, I often turn to the other Gospel accounts. It's another way for me to understand Christ better. I am getting a more complete story.

I can also get a more complete understanding of Christ through others around me. In my small faith sharing group, Whole Community Sunday, and conversations as I minister with young adults, I see how others have unique experiences of Christ in their lives! I learn how others experience Jesus, and this gives me an opportunity to know him better.

We need to share our faith experiences with each other. Even when I doubt, like Thomas, I need others to show me the way. So, let's keep sharing our stories with one another!

Hospitality: It's what we all share

“Do not neglect hospitality, for through it some have unknowingly entertained angels.” (Heb.13:2)

Our welcome extends to all. Accountability resides in how we put our welcome into action. It is not ours to judge those who seek Jesus and have faith. A large part of the ministry of Jesus involved the dismantling of cultural barriers and extending a sense of belonging for those especially cast down.

You’ve heard it said that “All are welcome at the Casa!” It is true ... and we mean it. We hope that each person who enters through our doors feels like they have just come "home." But saying *all are welcome* and *offering hospitality* are not the same thing. Creating a hospitable environment is a task that belongs to all of us. Instinctively, we already know how to do this — it’s often the little things like:

1. Smiling and greeting one another generously
2. Holding doors open for people behind you
3. Sliding over in the pews to make room — and doing it willingly (not begrudgingly)
4. Helping visitors find water fountains, restrooms, or the changing tables for babies
5. Encouraging visitors to stay hydrated while visiting Arizona
6. Encouraging guests to learn more about the Casa at a “Discover the Vision” tour or a church art & architecture tour
7. Inviting visitors to return to Mass at the Casa
8. Inviting others to join you for refreshments after Mass
9. Staying after Mass and mingling; making new friends and acquaintances
10. Looking for people who are sitting alone, sitting with them or inviting them to sit with you, helping them feel that they belong here

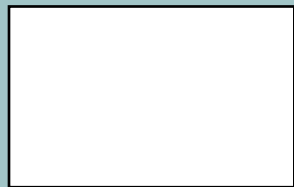

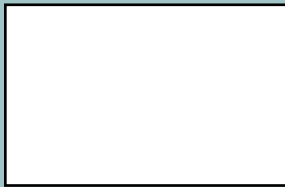
