Dear Holy People of God,
 All the readings of this Sunday convey a message of repentance. However, in the first reading, we see God repenting of His will to destroy the city of Nineveh. Some of you might question that why God has to repent.

In biblical language, God's actions are sometimes described anthropomorphically, using human-like language to help convey a complex concept to human understanding. God, being perfect and unchanging, does not experience the same emotions and changes of mind as humans do. The use of the term "repent" in this context is more about God's mercy and willingness to forgive rather than a change of God's essential nature.

The story of Jonah illustrates God's compassion and desire for repentance and redemption. The people of Nineveh responded to Jonah's warning by repenting of their sins, and in response, God chose not to bring the destruction He had initially declared. It serves as a powerful message about God's mercy and the potential for forgiveness when people turn from their sinful ways.

The Cambridge Dictionary defines repentance as "the fact of showing that you are very sorry for something bad you have done in the past, and wish that you had not done it." This is the common understanding. However, based on the context of the first reading, repentance means changing one's ways or turning away from a certain course of action.

The Word of God this Sunday calls us to come to a complete stop and make a U-turn from what is considered wrong.
